

TEAM CAPTAIN LETTER 4 – GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

Dear team captain,

Just a few more days until the start of the 52nd Batavierenrace. We as an organisation are very much looking forward to it and we hope you are just as excited! I hereby send you the last important information.

BEFORE THE RACE

• The buses for which you have been able to purchase bus coupons will depart from the following locations:

Enschede: Calslaan (Sports Centre) Nijmegen: Driehuizerweg (RSC)

Ulft: Frank Daemenstraat Barchem: Parking Borculoseweg

- Team captains must first report to the bike light check before they can collect the team captain's bag and cyclist's vest.
- The correct order is as follows: bike light control > collect bag/cyclist's vest > team captain's briefing. The times are as follows:

20:00 - 21:30 Bike light check - Location: pit frontside RSC Nijmegen
20:00 - 21:30 Team captain's report and issuing of the cyclists' vest - Location: Sporthal 1, entrance by the climbing wall, RSC Nijmegen)
22:00 - 22:45 Team captain's briefing - Location: Sporthal 1, entrance by the climbing wall, RSC Nijmegen)

- If you as team captain cannot be at the team captain's briefing, you may send the contact person of the nightshift as a delegate.
- A lot of important information is listed in team captain's letter 3. Please read it again carefully! It can also be found on the website under <u>'Team captain' ></u> <u>'Information for team captains'</u>.
- There are extra team captain's briefings in Ulft and in Barchem. They are mandatory to attend for the contact persons from the morning and day shifts. They will take place every fifteen minutes. The briefing in Ulft (05:45-07:15) will be in the Rabobankzaal, in Barchem (10:45-12:15) in the big room on the ground floor.

DURING THE RACE

- The weather looks variable for next weekend. There may be some rain and it may be very chilly at night and in the morning. During the day it can get quite warm. Therefore, be sure to bring plenty of warm, dry clothes.
- It's mandatory to have two bottles of water per runner in the participant van. So make sure you bring enough water, and don't forget to take enough water with you on the bike. Be aware, this can be checked!
- It is forbidden to drive with the participant van on the runner's route. After a first time you will receive a warning, if it happens a second time the entire team will be disqualified.



- You may bring a tandem for the accompanying cyclist. In that case, make sure to bring your own extra reflective vest for the cyclist on the back seat.
- Stage 12 has been lengthened by 0.4km, from 3.6km to 4.0km.
- There are a number of mandatory runner-cyclist-changes during the race. These are at switching point 3 (between stages 3 and 4) and switching point 10 (between stages 10 and 11).
- During the night, it is mandatory for runners to wear a white light on the front and a red light on the back, for everybody's safety. So make sure you have lights for this. Bike lights are sufficient.
- The second stage is quite dark, so we recommend you use a head light during this stage. Make sure your runner on stage 2 is aware of this.
- During the center stage (stage 1) and the last stages (stage 24/25), the accompanying cyclist cannot join the route with the runner. Please keep this in mind.
- During the men's final stage (stage 25), a motorcycle will precede the runners and thus encounter the ladies during their final stage. It is therefore important that ladies walk on the right side of the road as much as possible during the final stage, so the motorcycle can easily pass them. This will be announced before the restart, but make sure your runner on stage 24 is aware of this.
- You're not allowed to take the bike with you to the Oude Markt in Enschede. So make sure you carry a lock with you, so you can stall your bike in the bicycle storage close to the Oude Mark.

GENERAL

- You will all receive a team captain's bag coming Friday with a route booklet in it. You will receive two booklets from the organisation: one for in the participant van (car route) and one for the accompanying cyclist (runner route). Drive over the car route, **absolutely do not** use Google Maps.
- The online participant booklet will be online this **Wednesday**. This booklet can be found via <u>info.batavierenrace.nl</u>. Besides all kinds of general information, the online participant booklet also contains the runner and car route.
- The errata of the route can be found in the online participants booklet under <u>'Routes' > 'General'</u> and will be in your team captain's bag. Please look at this carefully!
- The starting list can be found on our website under <u>'Team captain' > 'Information</u> for team captains'. Also make sure you know which start group you are in!
- Stay up to date during the race via BataRadio! Here you can hear interviews, games, artists, information about the race and of course music! You can listen to BataRadio from Friday, May 24th at 20.00 until Saturday, May 25th at 02.00, and on Saturday May 25th from 08:00 until 19:00 on 1Twente (105.1 FM) or on <u>bataradio.nl</u>.
- Throughout the weekend, deposit bottles and cans will be collected for the charity Beat Batten. During the race, you can collect these in the orange trash bag found in the team leader's bag. The blue trash bag is for residual waste. On the campus in Enschede you can hand in the orange bag for charity. On every campsite there is a collection point for deposit bottles and cans.

CAMPING AND PARTY

• This year there will not be a charging station on campus. So don't forget to bring your power bank!



- A group of masseuses from Topvorm Twente will be on campus in Enschede to provide free massages. The massages will take place in SC6 in the sports center on Saturday from 12:00 to 18:30. It is mandatory to shower before use and bring your own towel!
- The dinner on Friday and Saturday night on the campus in Enschede will be provided by Domino's. On Friday the take-out point will be opened between 16:00 and 19:00, on Saturday between 16:00 and 19:30. This location is listed in the online participant booklet. You must order your own pizzas from Domino's though!
- As every year there is the possibility to stay overnight at the campsite on the UT campus. All information and rules about this are on the website under <u>'Participant'</u>
 <u>'Sleeping Arrangements'</u> and in the online participant booklet under Program.
- White goods are not allowed in the campsites!
- The party site on the campus in Enschede will open at 20:00. You will have to pay one beverage coin (worth €2.50) for each entrance.
- At the party you will receive an eco coin that can be exchanged for a cup at the bar. If you lose your eco coin and cup, you will have to pay one beverage coin to get a new cup.
